



Permanent Municipal Hazardous or Special Waste (MHSW) Depot

The Municipal Hazardous or Special Waste (MHSW) Permanent Depot is now open. Bring your household hazardous waste to the permanent depot NOW to avoid long wait times during the Spring and Summer seasons.

Located at the Oxford County Landfill, 384060 Salford Road, the depot will accept household hazardous waste generated within Oxford County only. Only waste from residential sources will be accepted at this time. Hazardous waste originating from businesses generating small quantities may be accepted at a later date.

Hours of Operation:
Saturday 8:00am – 4:00pm

Acceptable items include:

- ✓ Paint
- ✓ Batteries (auto, alkaline and rechargeable)
- ✓ Pharmaceuticals
- ✓ Sharps (needles, lancets-must be in a sealed puncture proof container)
- ✓ Propane tanks
- ✓ Fluorescent light tubes and bulbs
- ✓ Motor oil and filters
- ✓ Pesticides
- ✓ Household cleaners
- ✓ Aerosols

Unacceptable items include:

- ✓ PCB material
- ✓ Radioactive material
- ✓ Flares, fireworks, ammunition
- ✓ Pathological material
- ✓ Open containers or leaking containers

Container size limited to a 5 gallon pail. No charge for dedicated loads of HHW. Mixed loads will be subject to tipping fees.
